- □ Sunscreen (at least SPF 30)
- BUG SPRAY
- Flashlight
- □ For personal drinking water...Camel back or water bottle or Two empty 2 liter plastic
- soda bottles with lids or its equivalent.

# Peace River Packing Only <sup>Clothes:</sup>



Pack in several small plastic bags that seal. Pack smaller bags in larger plastic bag (garbage bag size). Put larger plastic bag in cloth bag such as duffel bag or pillow case and tie. Cloth bag protects plastic bag from punctures. Squeeze air from bags before sealing. Put in 5 gallon bucket or waterproof gear bag.

#### **Sleeping Bag:**

It should be in two garbage type plastic bags inside a 5 gallon bucket.

#### **Toiletry Articles:**

They can be in plastic bags inside small drawstring cloth bags. It is good to have these packed separately so you can get to them without risk of other things getting wet.


**Note**: Lake Aurora does not provide 5 gallon buckets for personal gear.


# **Driving Directions**


#### In your hand please have:
